North is known for tall trees and small farms of corn, cassava, beans and okra. Entrepreneurs are branching into landscape gardens and fruit orchards. Also the home of the finest Caicos sloop builders on the sea. The shallow waters of Bottle Creek are a favourite for bonefishing, kayaking, birdwatching and isolated picnics. Wades Green was one of the most successful Loyalist era plantations. A walking tour of the well preserved ruins is a one mile gentle hike over old roadways. Call 243-6877 to arrange access.

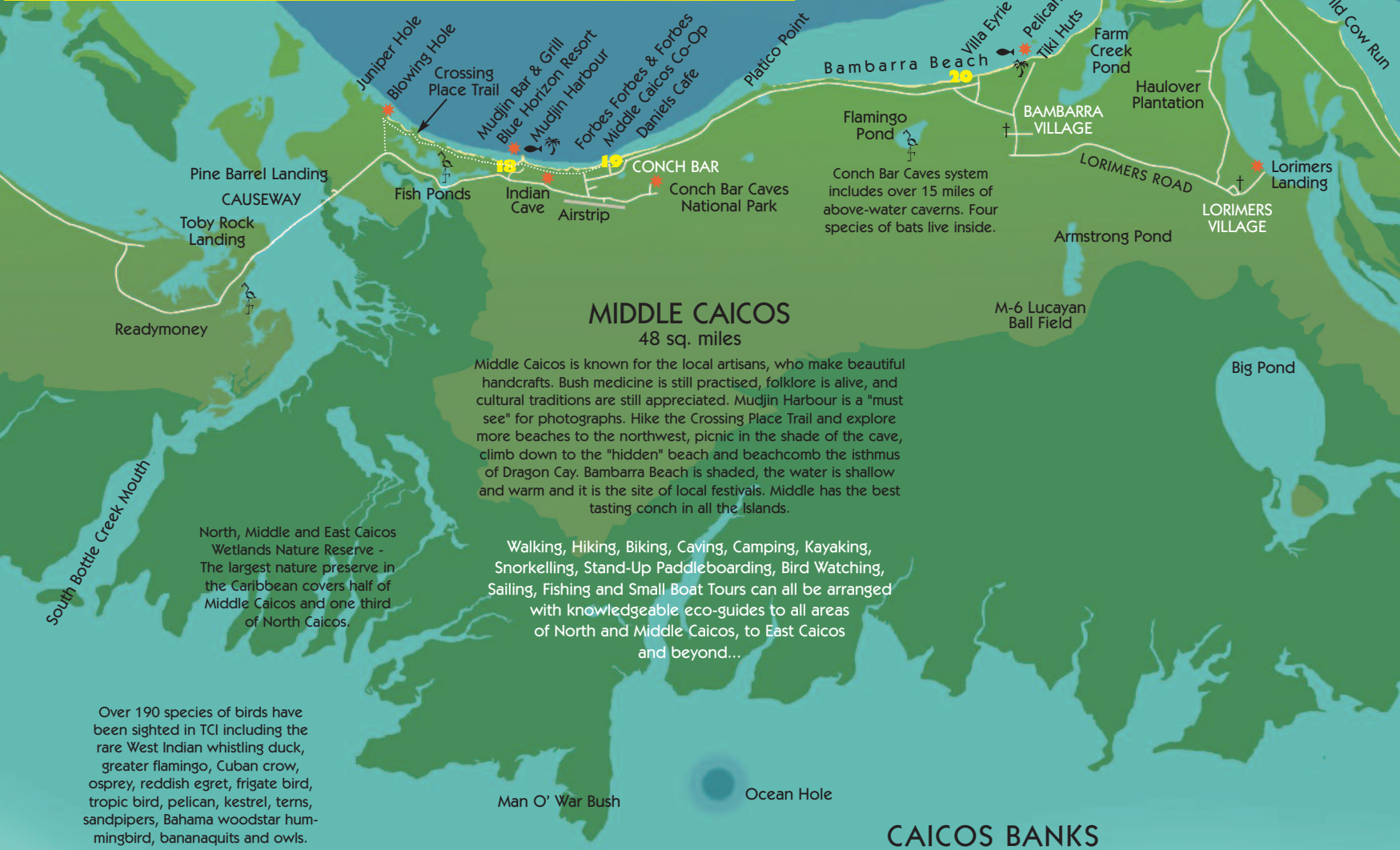

Middle Caicos was inhabited by the Taino, (Lucayan Indians) from 750-1500 AD, until the Spanish enslaved them, introduced diseases, and effectively destroyed their civilization. British Loyalists established huge plantations in the Caicos Islands (late 1780s) and grew cotton/sisal for only one generation. The majority abandoned their lands when slavery was outlawed and the true difficulties of farming on these isolated islands became apparent. They left their lands to their former slaves - these plots are now known as generational lands.



MIDDLE CAICOS 48 sq. miles

Middle Caicos is known for the local artisans, who make beautiful handcrafts. Bush medicine is still practised, folklore is alive, and cultural traditions are still appreciated. Mudjin Harbour is a "must see" for photographs. Hike the Crossing Place Trail and explore more beaches to the northwest, picnic in the shade of the cave, climb down to the "hidden" beach and beachcomb the isthmus of Dragon Cay. Bambarra Beach is shaded, the water is shallow and warm and it is the site of local festivals. Middle has the best tasting conch in all the Islands.

Walking, Hiking, Biking, Caving, Camping, Kayaking, Snorkelling, Stand-Up Paddleboarding, Bird Watching, Sailing, Fishing and Small Boat Tours can all be arranged with knowledgeable eco-guides to all areas of North and Middle Caicos, to East Caicos and beyond...

North, Middle and East Caicos Wetlands Nature Reserve - The largest nature preserve in the Caribbean covers half of Middle Caicos and one third of North Caicos.

Over 190 species of birds have been sighted in TCI including the rare West Indian whistling duck, greater flamingo, Cuban crow, osprey, reddish egret, frigate bird, tropic bird, pelican, kestrel, terns, sandpipers, Bahama woodstar hummingbird, bananaquits and owls.
